

How to Cure the “SHRINKS”



- Has a test or trial shrunk your faith?
- Was the test so severe that you felt like there was no hope for a solution?

BIBLICAL BACKGROUND

Key Word in Hebrews: (Gk. *Kreitton*) “superior” “more excellent”

Outline of Hebrews: (Application Study Bible, p. 2060)

II. THE SUPERIORITY OF **FAITH**. Heb. 10:19 - 13:25

Our Text: A transition from Christ to Our **Responsibility**.

Central Lesson:

Cure the “Shrinks” by Persevering in God’s “Let Us” Patch!

Text: Hebrews 10:19-25 NLT. A Call to Persevere!

I. **RECALL** YOUR ATTACK OF THE “SHRINKS.”

A. Their **Trouble** - “**Terrible Suffering**” Heb. 10:32-34

v. 32 NIV “great conflict”:

B. God’s **Threat** - “**I will take no pleasure in anyone who turns away!**” 10:38 NLT. (Heb. 2:3-4) “Shrinking” is a Biblical term for “Retreating,” to “Turn away.”

C. Your **Test** - Can you measure your faith?

- **Ask:** How am I responding to this test?

“² ...when troubles of any kind come your way, consider it an opportunity for great joy. ³ For you know that when your faith is tested, your endurance (NIV perseverance) has a chance to grow.

⁴ So let it grow (NIV perseverance finish its work), for when your endurance is fully developed, you will be perfect (NIV mature) and complete, needing nothing.” James 1:2-4 NLT

“Don’t be dejected and sad, for the joy of the Lord is your strength.” Nehemiah 8:10c NLT

II. **REVIEW** CHRIST’S INVITATION. Hey. 10:19-21

A. Jesus’ Blood Opened the **Way** to God

“¹⁹ And so (NIV SINCE), dear brothers and sisters, we can boldly enter heaven’s Most Holy Place because of the blood of Jesus. ²⁰ By his death, Jesus opened a new and life-giving way through the curtain into the Most Holy Place.” 10:19-21

Our walk with the Lord is to be confident!

- In Contrast:
- But now: “*a new and life-giving way.*” 10:20

(Psa. 118:19-24; by faith Heb. 11:6)

- It is possible to have a “holy place” **within us**. Jesus invites us to **enter**, but be **clean!**
 - B. **Jesus’ Presence Rules** the House (Inner Being) “*And SINCE we have a great High Priest who rules over God’s house....*” Heb. 10:21
- Our walk with the Lord** is based on **Who Jesus is**, our Supreme High Priest! 10:10, 14
- **Acts** records the Lordship of Christ. 110x.
 - It is IMPOSSIBLE to correctly communicate Christ while we are outside His house.
 - **Does Jesus rule over you completely?**

III. **RENEW** YOUR SPIRITUAL EXERCISES 10:22-25

The “LET US” Patch!

A. “Let Us” **Draw Near** to God — In Purity.

*“...let us go right into the presence of God with sincere hearts **fully trusting** him (faith). For our guilty consciences have been sprinkled with Christ’s blood to make us clean, and our bodies have been washed with pure water.” 10:22*

1. Be **cleansed** of a guilty conscience. Is your loyalty divided when you pray? Jas. 1:6-8
2. Be **washed** with pure water (not baptism), but by the Holy Spirit. (Ezek. 36:25; 1 Cor. 6:11, 18-20). Have you been cleansed of filth? James 1:19-22.

B. “Let Us” **Speak Out** — About Our Hope

*“Let us hold tightly without wavering to the **hope we affirm**, for God can be trusted to keep his promise.” 10:23*

The believer has an inner hope that is greater than any external solutions.

C. “Let Us” **Stir Up** — Encouraging and Affirming Others *“²⁴ Let*

*us think of ways to motivate one another to **acts of love** and good works. ²⁵ And let us not neglect our meeting together, as some people do, but encourage one another, especially now that the day of his return is drawing near.” 10:24-25. (Rom. 8:28)*

Key Verses: Hebrews 10:35-36 NLT *“³⁵ So do not throw away this confident trust in the Lord. Remember the great reward it brings you! ³⁶ Patient endurance is what you need now, so that you will continue to do God’s will. Then you will receive all that he has promised.”*

CONCLUSION: Cure the Shrinks by obeying the commands in the lettuce patch: draw ...speak out...sit up. **God had the solution before we had that “hopeless” problem.**

Central Lesson:

Cure the “Shrinks” by Persevering in God’s “Let Us” Patch!
